Unit definition

Pectinase

1 Unit is that amount of enzymatic activity which catalyzes the liberation of 1 µmol of reducing groups from pectic acid per minute at 25°C, pH 4.5, calculated as D-galacturonic acid.

Cellulase

1 Unit is that amount of enzymatic activity which catalyzes the liberation of 1 µmol glucose from sodium carboxymethyl cellulose per minute at 40°C, pH 4.5.

Hemicellulase

1 Unit is that amount of enzymatic activity which liberates 1 µmol of reducing groups from beechwood xylan per hour at 37°C, pH 5.5, calculated as xylose.
